- We want to provide CHF 300 billion in sustainable financing by 2030. Over the past two years, we have already reached CHF 60 billion.
- We have been a member of the Sustainable Markets Initiative launched by the Prince of Wales since 2021. It is aimed at accelerating the financial industry's transition to net zero.
