Terms & Conditions

OBJECTIVE

Credit Suisse ("Credit Suisse") wishes to encourage Undergraduate and Masters University students to consider careers within the Credit Suisse Technology (IT) team in Hong Kong. Credit Suisse is proud to introduce CodeIT Suisse, an online coding challenge whereby the top four teams and individuals will be awarded prizes with a combined value of HK\$33,500 ("CodeIT Suisse").

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to enter into CodelT Suisse, participants must be an Undergraduate or Masters University student and scheduled to graduate in December 2023, 2024, 2025 or 2026. Participants may apply on an individual basis or form a team of 2-3 eligible participants. Participants from any previous Hong Kong CodelT Suisse events who meet the above criteria are welcome to apply again for CodelT Suisse in 2022. Immediate family members of employees at Credit Suisse and its subsidiaries and affiliates and past interns or employees at Credit Suisse are not eligible to participate. Each applicant, applying as a team or individual, must submit one application and solution to the problem statement before the application deadline to be considered. No additional team members will be accepted once the shortlisting process is completed. Multiple applications by the same person or team for CodelT Suisse are not permitted and shall result in disqualification.

CONDUCT OF CODEIT SUISSE

Applications will be reviewed and shortlisted applicants will be selected and invited to participate in a coding challenge ("Coding Challenge") which shall take place online. Each team's solutions to the problems presented during the Coding Challenge ("Solutions") will be assessed at the end of the Coding Challenge.

(i) Application:

Each participant must submit an application providing their CV and Repl.it URL of the solution to the problem statement ("Application"). If a participant is applying as part of a team, he/she should indicate the team name and the full names of all team members in the application so that Credit Suisse can make arrangements for the team. The closing date for Applications is 23:59 on Sunday, September 11, 2022.

Participants will be selected and invited to attend the Coding Challenge during the weekend of September 17 – 18, 2022.

(ii) Coding Challenge:

- The Coding Challenge will take place from the morning of Saturday, September 17, 2022 (online) to the afternoon of Sunday, September 18, 2022 (in-person).
- Teams will be presented with problems at various times throughout the Coding Challenge.
- Teams are permitted to work on the Solutions to such problems at any time from 09:00 Saturday, September 17, 2022 to 10:00 Sunday, September 18, 2022.

(iii) Submission of Solutions:

 Each team's Solutions must be submitted to the system provided by Credit Suisse by 10:00 on Sunday, September 18, 2022 ("Submission Deadline") and can also be submitted periodically throughout the weekend onto the provided system prior to the Submission Deadline. Details on the submission of Solutions will be provided during the Coding Challenge.

(iv) Final Evaluation:

- During the Final Evaluation, each team's Solutions will be tested with an automated evaluator developed by Credit Suisse ("Automated Evaluator") to assess the Solutions functionality and performance. The team with the highest number of points awarded by the Automated Evaluator will win CodelT Suisse 2022. Further details on the assessment process and the awarding of points will be provided during the Coding Challenge.
- Solutions with broken links or crashes will result in a penalty during the Final Evaluation.
- Credit Suisse reserves all rights to develop, make any necessary changes to and interpret any results derived from, the Automated Evaluator, and to do so in its sole and absolute discretion.
- Decisions made by the CS Panel and/or Credit Suisse will be final and binding.

(v) Results:

• The results of CodelT Suisse will be announced on Sunday, September 18, 2022.

The Application, Solutions and any other submissions made in relation to CodelT Suisse are herein collectively referred to as the "Submissions".

By applying for CodelT Suisse, applicants agree that they have read, understood and agreed to the terms and conditions of CodelT Suisse as set out in this document.
